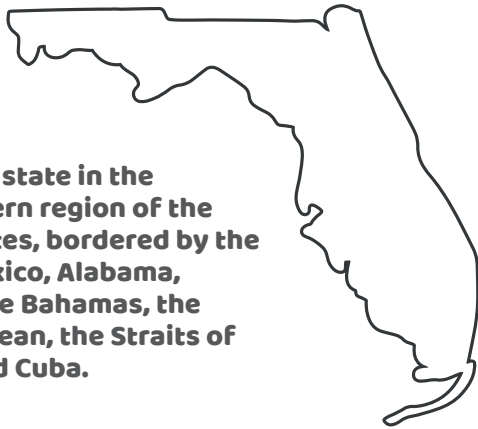


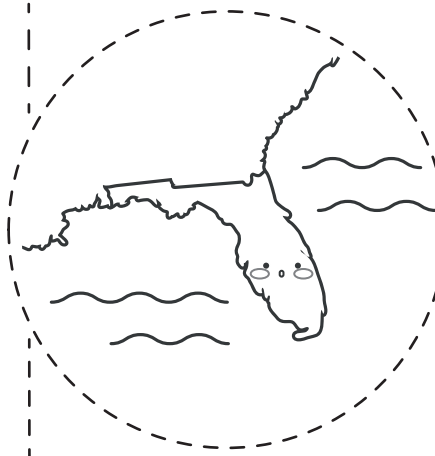


# Florida Facts

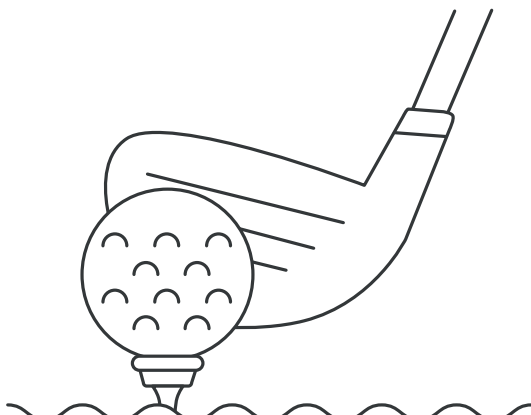


It is the only state bordering both the Gulf of Mexico and the Atlantic Ocean.

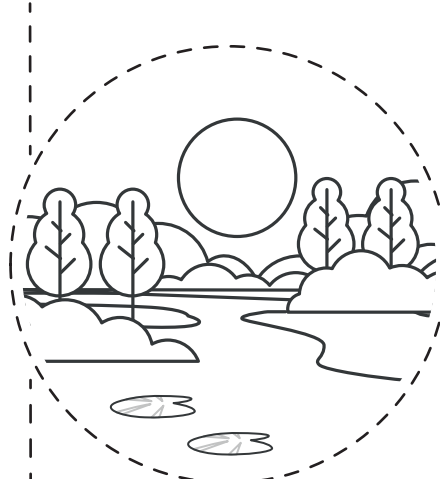
Florida is the flattest state in the continental United States because the highest point in the state is only 345 feet above sea level.

More than 1,250 Floridian golf courses exist, more than any other State.



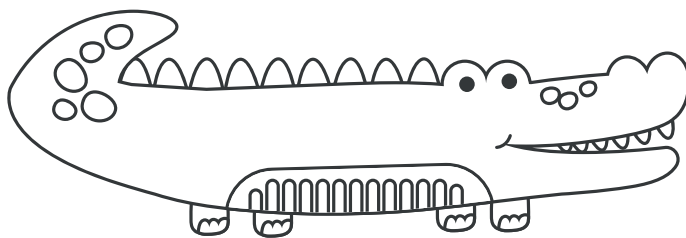
There's more than just Miami beach: Miami is the only metropolitan area in America with two national parks: the Everglades National Park and Biscayne.

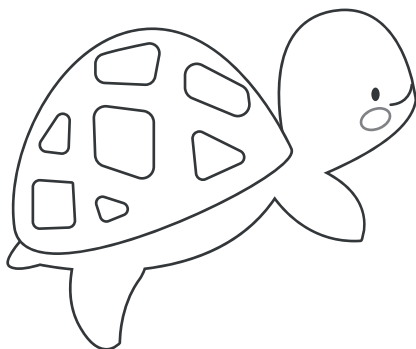

The American alligator is a large aquatic reptile and is one of two crocodilians native to Florida.

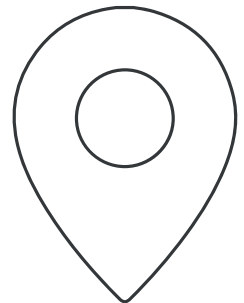


There are more than a dozen original Native American tribes in the state of Florida.
